### **INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGIES**

The investment objective of the CI Global Equity & Income Fund (the Fund) is to achieve a high level of income by investing primarily in fixed income and high-yielding equity securities and other income-producing securities throughout the world.

To achieve the investment objective of the Fund, the portfolio advisor actively manages the Fund using equity, fixed income instruments, and cash and cash equivalents. The Fund is not limited to how much it invests in each asset class or geographic mix, which may vary according to market conditions.

The Fund's equity portion includes equities that are expected to distribute income such as common shares, preferred shares, real estate investment trusts, royalty trusts and similar high-yielding investments. Fixed income securities may include corporate bonds and government fixed income securities throughout the world. It may also invest in bank loans, convertible bonds, floating rate debt instruments, exchanged-traded funds and closed-end funds.

The portfolio advisor may use techniques such as fundamental analysis to assess growth and value potential. This means evaluating the financial condition and management of each company, its industry and the overall economy. As part of this evaluation, the portfolio advisor analyzes credit ratings, financial data and other information sources, assesses the quality of management and conducts company interviews.

#### **RISK**

No changes affecting the overall level of risk associated with investing in the Fund were made during the period/year. The risks of the Fund remain as discussed in the Fund's most recently filed simplified prospectus or its amendments. The Manager reviews the risk rating for the Fund on an annual basis, at a minimum, based on the methodology mandated by the Canadian Securities Administrators to determine the risk level of the Fund. Any change to the risk rating made during the period/year was as a result of such review and was not a result of any change to the investment objective, strategies or management of the Fund.

### **RESULTS OF OPERATIONS**

The Fund's net assets decreased by \$148.9 million to \$511.7 million from March 31, 2022 to March 31, 2023. The Fund had net redemptions of \$61.4 million during the year. The portfolio's performance decreased assets by \$42.4 million. The Fund paid distributions totalling \$45.1 million. Series A units returned -6.7% after fees and expenses for the one-year period ended March 31, 2023. Over the same time period, the Fund's benchmark returned -3.1%. The benchmark is a combination of the FTSE Canada Universe Bond Total Return Index - 60% and the S&P/TSX Composite Total Return Index - 40% (the Benchmark or the Index).

The performance of the Fund's other Series is substantially similar to that of Series A units, except for differences in the structure of fees and expenses. For the returns of the Fund's other Series, please refer to the "Past Performance" section.

The following commentary pertains to the results of operations of the Underlying Funds.

During the year, rapidly rising inflation led many central banks to aggressively raise interest rates. There was a corresponding decline in equity valuations and stock prices. Throughout the year, markets experienced a heightened level of volatility.

The Fund underperformed its benchmark for the year. Exposure to bonds detracted from the Fund's performance, particularly longer-term bonds as interest rates rose over the year. An overweight allocation to the financials sector within the Fund's equity component also detracted from performance. Individual detractors from the Fund's performance included equity positions in First Republic Bank and Altice USA Inc., preferred shares issued by Altera Infrastructure L.P. and a U.S. Treasury 1.625% Nov. 15, 2050 bond holding.

Allocation to equities contributed to the Fund's performance. An underweight exposure to the real estate sector contributed to the Fund's performance, as did an overweight exposure to the materials sector. Top individual contributors to the Fund's performance included overweight positions in McKesson Corp. and Linde PLC. A lack of exposure to Amazon.com Inc. and Tesla Inc. also contributed to the Fund's relative performance.

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There was a heightened level of market risk during the year, which contributed to increased overall portfolio volatility. We added new positions in The Bank of Nova Scotia 3.7% Jul. 27, 2081 bonds and AstraZeneca PLC to the Fund and increased existing holdings in Deutsche Telekom AG and U.S. Treasury 1.875% Feb. 15, 2041 bonds. Holdings in U.S. Treasury 1.5% Nov. 30, 2028 bonds and Elevance Health Inc. were eliminated from the Fund, while a holding in Broadcom Inc. was trimmed.

### RECENT DEVELOPMENTS

In our view, economic activity is likely to contract in the coming period. As such, we have increased the Fund's exposures to less economically sensitive sectors, such as consumer staples and health care, for defensive purposes. The Fund's equity exposure has been trimmed and its bond allocation increased.

#### Administrator

Effective October 24, 2022, RBC Investor Services Trust ceased acting as the administrator to the Fund and CIBC Mellon Global Securities Services Company started acting as the administrator to the Fund.

### Independent Review Committee

Effective October 6, 2022, John Sheedy became a member of the Independent Review Committee (IRC) of CI Funds.

### **RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS**

### Manager, Portfolio Adviser, Trustee and Registrar

CI Investments Inc. is the Manager, Portfolio Adviser, Trustee and Registrar of the Fund. CI Investments Inc. is a subsidiary of CI Financial Corp. The Manager, in consideration for management fees, provides management services required in the day-to-day operations of the Fund. The Manager bears all of the operating expenses of the Fund (other than taxes, borrowing costs and new governmental fees) in return for an administration fee.

The Manager received \$8.8 million in management fees and \$1.1 million in administration fees for the year.

### Management Fees

Approximately 31% of total management fees were used to pay for sales and trailing commissions. The remaining 69% of management fees were used to pay for investment management and other general administration.

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### Portfolio Sub-Advisor

CI Global Investments Inc., an affiliate of CI Investments Inc., provides investment advice to the Fund.

### Related Fund Trading

Related fund trading occurs when a Fund purchases or sells units/shares of another Fund managed by the Manager. During the period/year ended March 31, 2023, the Fund engaged in related fund trading or held position(s) in related fund(s) at the end of the period/year.

### Independent Review Committee

The Manager, in respect of the Fund, received the following standing instructions from the IRC with respect to related party transactions:

The applicable standing instructions require, amongst others, that related party transactions be conducted in accordance with the Manager's policies and procedures and applicable law and that the Manager reports related party transactions periodically to the IRC and advise the IRC of any material breach of such policies. The Manager's policies and procedures require that investment decisions in respect of related party transactions (a) are free from any influence by an entity related to the Manager and without taking into account any consideration relevant to an entity related to the Manager; (b) represent the business judgment of the Manager, uninfluenced by considerations other than the best interests of the Fund; (c) do not exceed the limitations of the applicable legislation; and (d) achieve a fair and reasonable result for the Fund.

Except as otherwise noted above under Related Party Transactions section, the Fund was not a party to any related party transactions during the period/year ended March 31, 2023. If the Fund invested in related party transactions, it relied on the IRC's standing instructions regarding related party transactions during this reporting period/year.

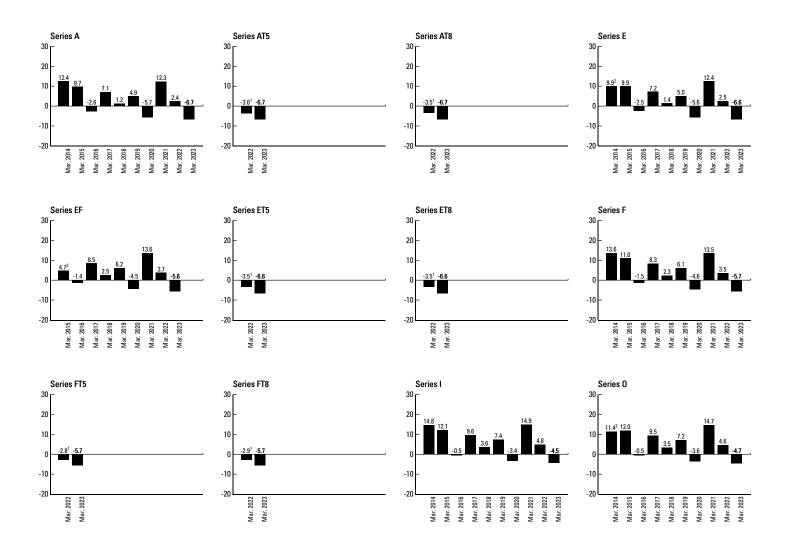

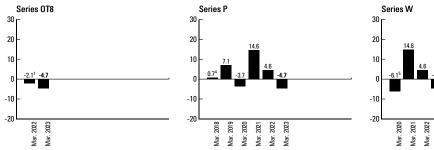

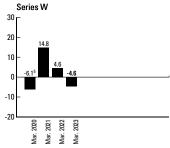

#### **Annual Compound Returns**

The following table shows the Fund's annual compound returns for each year indicated, compared to the Blended Index composed of: (60% - FTSE Canada Universe Bond Total Return Index and 40% - S&P/TSX Composite Total Return Index); the FTSE Canada Universe Bond Total Return Index and the S&P/TSX Composite Total Return Index.

The S&P/TSX Composite Index is a float-adjusted market capitalization weighted index, which is the principal broad measure of the Canadian equity market. It includes common stocks and income trust units of companies incorporated in Canada which are listed on the Toronto Stock Exchange.

The FTSE Canada Universe Bond Index is a market capitalization weighted index that measures the performance of the Canadian investment-grade fixed income market. The Index consists of fixed rate bonds denominated in Canadian dollars, with a remaining effective term to maturity of at least one year, rated BBB or higher. The Index is comprised of four main credit or borrower categories: bonds issued by the Government of Canada (including Crown Corporations), Provincial bonds (including provincially-guaranteed securities), Municipal bonds and Corporate bonds. The Corporate sector is further divided into sub-sectors based on major industry groups: Financial, Communication, Industrial, Energy, Infrastructure, Real Estate and Securitization. The Corporate sector is also divided into sub-indices based on credit rating: a combined AAA/AA sector, a single A sector and a BBB sector.

A discussion of the performance of the Fund as compared to the benchmark is found in the Results of Operations section of this report.
