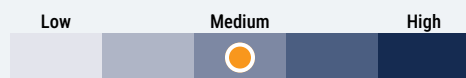

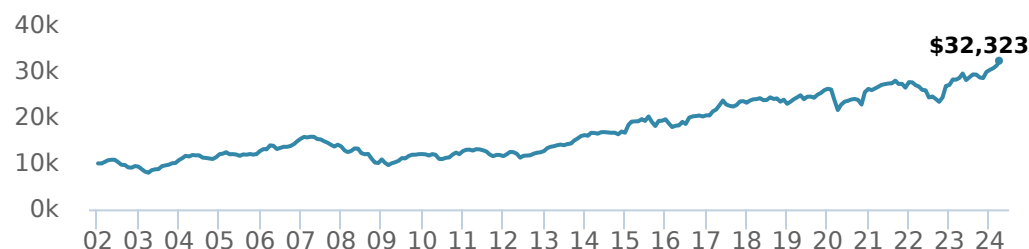

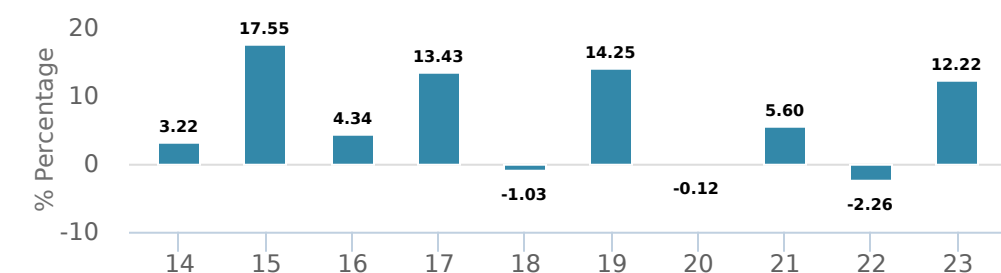

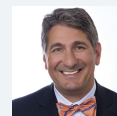
MANAGEMENT TEAM
