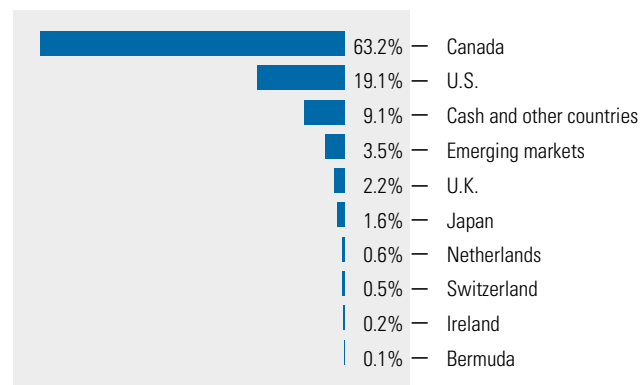

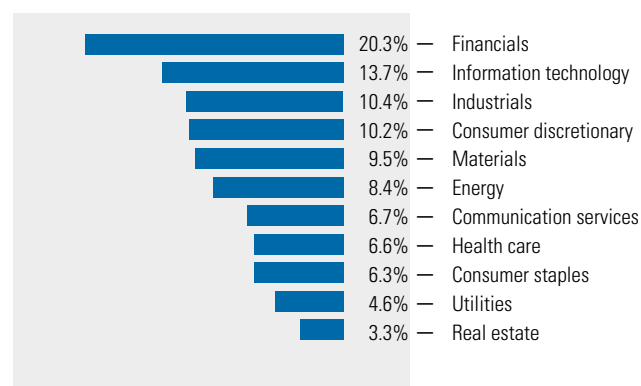
Geographic Regions



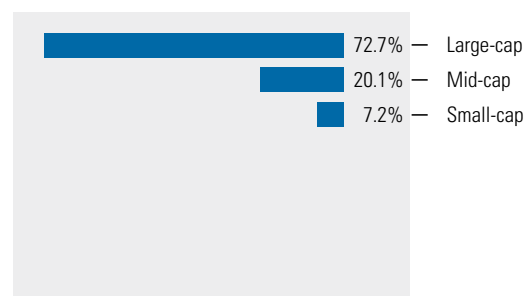
